- Ensuring delivery and execution of the finance actuals, closing and reporting activities for assigned reporting unit(s) - Performs a sanity check of the P&L and coordinates variances analysis actuals compared to reference period (e.g., prior month, quarter, or run-rate and / or forecast) on consolidated level
- Independently prepare local statutory reporting for certain entities, ensuring compliance with IFRS, internal guidelines and local GAAP. This includes the preparation of balance sheets, profit & loss statements, explanatory notes, and technical delivery of datasets on a monthly, quarterly, yearly or project base for both IFRS and local GAAP.
- Exercising independent judgement and decision -making within the scope of the role, which offers a degree of autonomy.
- Assisting in the preparation of tax accounts to ensure accuracy and compliance.

- Acting as a primary contact for group functions, business units, external auditors and other stakeholders.
- Analyzing financial statements, including balance sheets, profit and loss statements and explanatory notes.
